Dear Friends of Mobility Matters,

As most of you are aware, Mobility Matters is a nonprofit organization that provides mobility management services in Contra Costa County, facilitating collaboration and coordination between public and private transportation providers, to help create a network of integrated options that primarily address the mobility needs of seniors, people with disabilities, and low income individuals. Our anchor service is a Transportation Information & Referrals Helpline that matches riders to the most appropriate transportation providers to meet their individual needs. This Helpline also supports individuals who need help utilizing our countywide transportation guide called "Way To Go Contra Costa!" both in hard copy and on the Internet. In addition, we directly provide two volunteer driver programs: "Rides for Seniors" for ambulatory individuals age 60 and older who cannot access other forms of transportation, and "Rides 4 Veterans" for disabled ambulatory veterans of any age who need one-on-one assistance. Since programs that are free to participants are not free to operate, we raise money on an ongoing basis to carry out our mission, primarily through grants and donations, including our Annual Raffle Fundraiser.
